Do You or Someone You Know Need Health Insurance?

A Community Outreach Worker with Covering Kids and Families is available to help you. Covering Kids and Families partners with schools, hospitals, clinics and various other community programs to assist children and families with their healthcare needs.

Hoosier Healthwise

- Women who are pregnant
- Children up to their 19th birthday
- Children or adults with medical disabilities

Wishard Advantage

- Designed to provide basic medical care for applicants' ages 19 and older residing in Marion County who are unable to afford private insurance.

Healthy Indiana Plan

HIP is for uninsured Hoosier adults between the ages of 19-64. Parents or caretaker relatives of children in the Hoosier Healthwise program are likely candidates for HIP.

Individuals must earn less than 200% of the federal poverty level (FPL). A single adult earning less than \$20,000, or families of four earning less than \$40,000 likely meet the basic financial requirements.

Hoosier Healthwise (18 & under, Pregnant Women or Persons w/disabilities)

- ❑ Social Security Numbers (cards for all persons in the house to prove household)
- ❑ Documentation of Pregnancy (if needed)
- ❑ Other Healthcare Insurance
- ❑ Immigration Status (passport, resident card, green card, etc)
- ❑ Proof of Income (last 3 months paycheck stubs) and any other (child support, social security, etc)
- ❑ Proof of No Income (I-Net Statement from unemployment office-WorkOne)
 - If not working, Statement of Support is needed from a working adult stating they are assisting you with your bills (include date, name, and contact number).
- ❑ Picture ID's (Passport, School ID's, and State ID's) especially if child is over 15 years of age
- ❑ Must have Birth Certificates for children, adult (if pregnant), certificate of naturalization

Wishard Advantage (ages 19 & older)

- ❑ Social Security Numbers/Cards of people in the household
- ❑ Other Health Coverage
- ❑ Proof of Income (1-3 months paycheck stubs) and any other (child support, social security, etc)
- ❑ Proof of No Income (I-Net Statement from unemployment office-WorkOne)
 - If not working, Statement of Support is needed from a working adult stating they are assisting you with your bills (include date, name, and contact number).
- ❑ Proof of Marion County Residence (i.e. lease, utility bill sent within last 30 days, envelope that has been mailed)

Healthy Indiana Plan (ages 19-64)

(Must be uninsured for at least 6 mos. & can't be eligible for employee-sponsored health insurance)

- ❑ Picture ID – Valid driver's license or state or student photo id card
- ❑ Proof of Citizenship – Legal birth certificate, Certificate of Naturalization, Certificate of Citizenship, or US passport (if issued with no restrictions), permanent resident card, alien registration card, or other documentation.
- ❑ Proof of Income – Wages, employment termination, self-employment, all Federal income (i.e. child support), workers compensation, disability, sick pay, unemployment, or other benefits.

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
